

Former Birmingham-Southern and Birmingham Volleyball Club player Kyndall Waters began coaching club volleyball while still attending BSC, and has been a member of the staff since then.

A native of Homewood, Ala., Waters also serves as Birmingham-Southern's Assistant Volleyball Coach as well as BSC's Assistant AD and Compliance Director. On the volleyball side, she assists Head Coach, Judy Green, with recruiting, team travel, game day operations, and day to day operations of the volleyball program. As Assistant AD she manages compliance duties for all 20 of BSC's sports and also coordinates the Panthers' marketing and promotions efforts as well as most athletic department events, ticket sales, and concessions.

Prior to her stint as Assistant AD, Waters served as BSC's Director of Marketing for a year, and was the Assistant Director of Marketing for a year prior to that. During the 2005-06 season, she was BSC's Athletics Intern.

Waters graduated with a Bachelor of Science in psychology from Birmingham-Southern in May 2005, and went on to earn her Master of Human Environmental Science with a concentration in Sport Management from The University of Alabama in August 2006.

As a player on the Hilltop, Waters, a setter, was a team captain all four seasons and broke almost every setting record in the books. She also earned Big South Conference All-Academic and Big South Presidential Honor Roll accolades, Strength and Conditioning All-American honors, and was the President and Co-Founder of BSC's chapter of Fellowship of Christian Athletes. Additionally, Waters was a member of the Dean's List, Mortar Board Honor Society, and Alpha Lambda Delta Honor Society. Waters was inducted into the Birmingham-Southern Sports Hall of Fame in October of 2010.
